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## INTRODUCTION

This is a report on the gubernatorial potential of Republican Vic Atiyeh. Results reflect the climate as of OCTOBER, 1973.

The study was conducted and compiled by Bardsley & Haslacher, Inc., an independent and impartial research organization, with offices in the Western United States.

### Objectives

Primary objectives of the study were to chart voter awareness of "Vic Atiyeh" and obtain potential strength measurements from trial heat contests.

Important! In evaluating "contestant" positions in trial heat races, the reader should remember that awareness plays a prominent part in results.

Research has repeatedly proved that a candidate with high awareness, particularly an incumbent, enjoys an inherent advantage over potential challengers.

Mr. Atiyeh, for example, has a present awareness base of 46%, as compared to 89% for Clay Myers. Barring an unusually strong protest vote, Mr. Myers should run ahead of Atiyeh, which he does.

This does not negate the fact that Mr. Atiyeh would enter the gubernatorial race as an underdog (as detailed in our meeting).

But, it helps to explain the distance between the candidates at this time which, mathematically, should narrow as Mr. Atiyeh's name and candidacy become better known (if, of course, he runs).

## INTRODUCTION

### Methodology

Sample for the study consisted of 645 personal, in-home interviews with registered voters in the state. The sample was a multi-stage, probability type, which guaranteed each adult Oregonian an equal opportunity of being interviewed.

The sample was designed as follows: In Multnomah, Washington and Clackamas Counties, the area was first divided into census tracts. Next, all blocks or block-like segments were numbered in serpentine fashion within tracts.

A standard table of random numbers was then applied, and 10 per cent of blocks in each tract were drawn for physical listing of dwelling units. After this, the sample was drawn by computing an interviewing interval which assigned specific households for contact.

In urban areas outside Metro Portland, the sample was designed in similar fashion, except that a pre-listing was not made. Instead, interviewers were supplied with detailed maps and instructed to contact every "nth" dwelling unit.

In rural areas, interviewers used a similar contact method, following prescribed routes on rural maps.

Field work for the study was conducted in October of 1973. A portion of each interviewer's work was validated for accuracy and authenticity.

## INTRODUCTION

### Sampling Variability

Every sample survey is subject to ranges of variability, or the chance that results might vary slightly, within known limits, from findings which a complete census would produce.

The following chart reflects variability ranges for the total sample, computed at the 95 per cent confidence level.

<u>Percentage in Report:</u>	<u>Plus or Minus Range of Variation</u>
10% or 90% . . . . .	2.4%
20% or 80% . . . . .	3.1
30% or 70% . . . . .	3.6
40% or 60% . . . . .	3.8
50% . . . . .	3.9

Example: Twenty-two per cent of the sample preferred Mr. Atiyeh in his trial confrontation with Robert Straub. Chances are 19 out of 20 that this preference figure (22%) is within approximately 3.1%, plus or minus, of the finding which would accrue from a complete canvass of registered voters in the state.

Variability ranges for subgroup breakdowns (by age, sex, etc.) are somewhat wider, due to reduced sample bases.

Awareness of Mr. Atiyeh in the Metro Portland area was 60%; in Washington County, 81 per cent. In the remainder of the state (excluding Metro Portland), his awareness was 33 per cent.
