- 7. **CIVIL RIGHTS PROCEDURE:** This is a great time to review our Civil Rights (CR) Procedure since it has been a few months since most staff received CR Training. A CR Binder is located at each site which contains an outline of the CR Procedure, CR Complaint Log, CR Complaint Forms (English & Spanish), and Chapter 11 from the CACFP Manual. The procedure is as follows:
 - 1. CR Complaint Received (Verbal or Written)
 - 2. Document Complaint in CR Complaint Log
 - 3. Give CR Complaint Form to Complainant (offering to help complainant complete)
 - 4. If CR Complaint Form is Returned, Forward completed CR Complaint Form to Val Laws @ CA Main Office IMMEDIATELY! The form must be forwarded by Val Laws to ODE within 3 working days for all CACFP related complaints.

Be sure to notify your supervisor for guidance throughout this process. If you have any questions Regarding this procedure, contact Val Laws – CACFP Coordinator.
