Here's How TLC Works...

Once a month, for six months, the TLC trainer comes to your site and leads a story-time and activities with your participation.


The trainer brings all materials and parent letters describing the activities during each visit.

On the first five visits, the trainer leaves Door Knob Book Bags and a tub of books, an informal lending library, for you and the families in your program's use.

For each mobile training visit, you receive one hour of training credit towards Child Care Division registration renewal and CDA.

The cost: \$50 for Family Child Care Providers and \$100 for Center-based Teachers.

With The Learning Circle, children can begin to see themselves as active participants in reading at a very young age.
