I'm pleased to announce that our own Renee Bruce will assume a new position effective July 19 as the agency's Community and Family Resources Director. As many of you know, we bid farewell to Roni Pham of our CCR&R program last week. Jenny Choban has agreed to step into this position for the interim. Once we've completed planning for CCR&R, job openings will be posted.

There are important changes regarding the agency's phone numbers and clients seeking information and referral. First, effective July 1, CAO will no longer offer general information and referral, so clients calling in on the 648-0829 number will be informed that CAO no longer offers this service, and then will be referred to our main number for CAO programs, 648-6646. The 648-0829 number will be disconnected January 1st, but a recording will continue to refer clients

An automated phone system will go into effect July 1 for people phoning in on the agency's main line, 648-6646. The bi-lingual message will route callers to various programs or refer them to partnering agencies or community groups where they can get help. It links them to a phone directory, if they so choose. Staff from I&R, administration and our transition team have worked on the content of the detailed phone tree message and Jose Gonzalez will record the messages. We will continue to develop and expand the I&R database we use and Jose will continue to coordinate this work.

I hope you are all looking forward to summer. Remember to mark your calendar for August 25th when we will hold our agency picnic at our Shelter Home. This year we will be celebrating the shelter's 25th birthday and CAO's 35th anniversary. I will keep you posted on other changes as they occur.
