INSURANCE REMINDER

I haven't received very many forms vet so I thought I should send this reminder.

- Insurance enrollment forms and/or Decline of insurance for yourself or your dependents are due by **June 1st.**
- Coverage for Providence ends June 30th.
- If you are keeping Kaiser, but adding or deleting dependents, you need to complete a new Kaiser enrollment form and turn it in to me by **June 1st.**

Response to some questions I've been getting:

- If you are going to change to PacifiCare, **AND** you are not changing doctors, all you need to do is let your doctor's office know that you are changing insurance companies. If you are taking medication, you will want your doctor to review the prescription coverage offered by PacifiCare and have them coordinate your medications to reduce or eliminate any interruption of medication.
- If you are going to change to PacifiCare, **AND** you need to change doctors, you need to select your new doctor (this info is required on the enrollment form) and contact your current doctor to request your records be sent to the new doctor.
- Selecting a new doctor is often difficult to do because of the very personal relationship we develop with them. As a part of the selection process, don't be afraid to ask for an appointment with a doctor specifically for the purpose of meeting and getting to know him/her to see if it is a good match for you.
