- 1. Trainings are listed on page 2 of this bulletin.
- 2. Self Assessment scheduling: Site/classroom Visits 1 per classroom (49 classrooms), preferably two visitors per classroom, PAS's contact volunteers, list available electronically on the network. Bus Rides- 12 routes, one visitor per route. Focus child 1 per classroom, each PAS completes 3 focus children, each CDLT member completes 2 children. File reviews 1 per classroom, completed for every focus child. Home Visits completed for focus children, try to coordinate with scheduled January Home Visits. Parent satisfaction surveys every child enrolled in the program receives a survey; parents complete the survey. Enrollment Files 30% of the files, random selection. HR/Personnel files 1 personnel file for each supervisor/manager, 3 per PAS/Transportation supervisor. Facilities inspections 1 per site/classroom by Motus consultant. Electronic Binders for each component Content Area Coordinators. All information turned in by January 29.
- 3. Monday January 18th is Martin Luther King Jr. day. No School. Courage, truth, justice, compassion, dignity and humility are all traits the late Rev. Martin Luther King Jr. exemplified. Supervisors will be contacting teachers to schedule review for focus children. Please remember that you need to schedule a home visit for the focus child also.
