1999-2000 Budget Approval

The Finance Committee met on July 20, 1999 and reviewed the final draft of CAO's 1999-00 fiscal year budget. Attached is a budget narrative, a summary of the budget. a revenue list and the fundraising plan for resource development. The committee recommends that the Board approve this budget.

COMMUNITY ACTION ORGANIZATION 1999-00 BUDGET NARRATIVE

- CAO's 1999-00 budget totals \$7,924.682, which is a \$447.682 increase over our 1998-1999 budget of \$7,477,000. The increase is primarily due to Head Start expansion, wage increases and an expanded resource development program. Attached is the budget document which addresses these overall goals:
 - Invest in wage improvements
 - Invest in resource development expansion
 - Expand Head Start services
 - · Reduce building deficit and debt
 - Maintain current level of central support; increase efficiency and effectiveness of fiscal system
 - Maintain current programs: focus on stabilizing shelter, emergency basic needs and information and referral funding
- 2. Our 1999-00 administrative budget is \$721.995 (9%), an increase of \$37.995 over our 1998-99 of \$684.000 (9.2%). This budget allows for the conversion to Great Plains Dynamics to improve financial systems and support, while adding only a minimal cost (\$6.000) due to greater efficiency
- 3. Personnel costs include a 3% COLA for July 1, 1999 and a 3% salary reserve for January 1, 2000 wage adjustments to phase in implementation of the wage comparability study. Adjustments will be made after the finance committee has reviewed mid-vear financials to assure affordability.
- 4. A reallocation of occupancy costs, per our auditors request, has shifted an additional \$100,000 to Head Start, based upon actual square footage used. This has a favorable impact on other programs.
- 5. The Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) allocation is \$225,000 and provides funding support for Resource Development, including volunteer co-ordination. This investment in fundraising will increase the amount of private funds available to directly support program services. Emergency Services continues to lack adequate core funding and will be the priority for private funds raised.
- Implemented consultant's recommendations for resource development staffing plan and goals. Resource Development has 3.8 FTE and proposes to raise \$747.799 in private funds, an increase of \$240.922 over 1998-99, of which \$495,817 will go to support 1999-2000 program services. This plan includes \$11,300 to support the projected cost of the first year of operating the Tigard shelter, which will be the responsibility of the East County Shelter Council. Attached is the fundraising plan.
- 7. This budget projects a \$127,000 surplus which includes receipt of an additional \$100,000 from CDBG to reduce our building deficit of \$230,000. CAO has an agreement signed with the Office of Community Development that allows us to receive an additional \$200,000 if available by 6-30-00. If CAO were to receive the full \$200,000 and create a \$227,000 year-end surplus, we would virtually eliminate our building debt and be in a position to build some reserves in the future.
