- When offering assistance, wait until the individual accepts your offer and listen to or ask for directions on how to assist them.
- Speak to the individual, not his or her interpreter, assistant or companion.
- Because a wheelchair is part of the individual's "personal space," no one should lean on, touch, or push a chair unless asked.
