Prenatal Outreach

Opening Doors is a free and voluntary prenatal outreach program that connects low-income pregnant women with services that help them have healthy babies. Our goal is to assist women with prenatal care early in their pregnancy to avoid emergency room visits, and better ensure a safe birth and healthy baby.

Our staff provides advocacy and education as well as reassuring support during pregnancy and for an additional 2 months following the birth.



How Opening Doors can Help

We can. . .

- expedite your enrollment in the Oregon Health Plan
- connect you with a Prenatal Care Provider
- assist in communications with your Prenatal Care Provider
- prepare you for childbirth and motherhood
- provide referrals to WIC and other needed services

Opening Doors is the Oregon MothersCare site for Washington County. We assist women to obtain prenatal services early in their pregnancy by assisting with expedited Oregon Health Plan applications, including CAWEM. We can also help women locate a prenatal care provider and make their first appointment.

- referrals to community resources

- assist parents in setting and achieving personal goals, and more...




Family Advocacy
