TOM, IT TERRIBLY NARD NOT FEEL SAD, NOT TO FEEL A LITTLE BIT LONERY — NOT TO FEEL AN AGONIZING SENSE OF LOSS. BUT IN THE SPIRIT OF YOUR WISHES, I ALSO FEEL GREEFUL FOR YOUR LIFE, AM VERY PROUD THAT YOU WERE A PRODUCT OF ORGON & THAT, BECAUSE OF YOU WE ALL SHARE THE EXORMOUS TOY OF WHAT GOD HAS GIVEN US.

YOU HAVE NOT REALLY GONE, FOR IN THIS ROW — AND THROUGHOUT
THIS MAGNIFICENT STATE — ARE THOSE OF YOU. NO ONE OF US MEASURES
UP TO YOUR BRAND SCALE, BUT WE ARE HELD AND QUEETIVERY
WE LOVE OUR STATE AND THE BEAUTY OF IT AS YOU DIO. AND
COULDAINTY WE WIN NOT LET GO AM THOSE VIRTUES, YOU SPOKE SO
BRILLIANTLY.

IT MIGHT SEEM A LITTLE AUDACIOUS, TOM, BUT I WOULD LIKE TO DEEP CONTENTS NAGGING CONCERN YOU ONCE EXPRESSED.

YOU SAID:

I'd done some audacious things, and they have cost me terribly. I say to myself: If I had held my tongue once in a while. . . . But why should I?

I'm sort of shattered, but I'm still useful. I'm just living day to day, making speeches and challenging the knownothings and trying to tell people that they're being heard again, And wondering where is the glow of yesteryear? Wondering where the heroes went, Gosh, I don't know how long ago they left.

Heroes are not giant statues framed against a red sky. They are people who say: This is my community, and it's my responsibility to make it better. Interweave all these communities, and you really have an America that is back on its feet, a comfortable nation to live in again. I really think we're gonna have to reassess what constitutes a hero.
